

## Digital Photo I Assignment #2. The Landscape – Cityscape

In this assignment you are to set the ISO of your camera to ISO 200. The subject of this assignment is the Landscape – Cityscape. What is a landscape or a cityscape is wide and varied, from a close-up of a flower to a wide vista. There is two made areas that you need to consider: Composition and Light. People may be in the photographs that you take, but they should not be the main subject of the photograph. You should take 30 or so images, but edit that work so that you will turn in 10 to 15 images for critique.

- Think about how composition relates to the story that you are trying to tell. Use the concepts of visual editing and to see as the camera sees. Take your time and consider how the different elements play a role in the final image. Think about how the functions of your camera (depth of field, perspective, and speed) affect the story that you want to tell.
- Try one series of four photographs using the white balance. Make one photograph using the daylight white balance and one another using the overcast white balance on a subject in direct sunlight. Take another set in overcast or open shade light.
- There should be a series of photographs no fewer than 5 photographs of one subject. In the work that you turn in for class, you should select one subject and take no less than 5 photographs, trying to make each image show something different in each photograph. Try to make one image show that you tried to be a little creative. This series may contain more than 5 images, but there should be at least 5. However many photographs you take for this part of the assignment you need to turn in for critique.
- Pay attention to the light. Most of your photographs should be taken with the sun to your back. If you shoot into the sun make sure that you have a reason for it. You may find the light better if you photograph either early or late in the day. Try to look for things that look best in the light that you have to deal with.
- Take notes on the attached form and remember the most important part of the assignment is to have fun!
